Saturday, October 20-21 2018 from 1:00PM until 4:00PM

The West Chester Amateur Radio Association based at the National Voice of America Museum of Broadcasting will be taking part in the **61st Annual Jamboree-on-the-Air (JOTA)**.

This is the largest annual Scouting event in the world that brings together more than one million Scouts from over 150 countries using Amateur Radio.

All levels of Scouting from *Tiger Cubs* to *Venturers* will have the opportunity to communicate with Scouts around town and around the world using the Amateur Radio stations located in the museum. The event will also feature special demonstrations of how radio technology work from the earliest experiments with magnetism in the 1800s through the development of today's technologies (Bluetooth and Wifi). Come and discover the important role of this historic landmark.

Scouts in uniform and Scout Leaders will have FREE admission to the museum that weekend. The admission fee is \$5.00 for adults and children under 12 is \$1.00.
