

The museum contains the VOA control room, 250KW Collins transmitter as well and other artifacts from the 1944 thru 1994 Bethany Relay Station operation. Exhibit hall dedicated to Crosley Corporation. The first transmitter for the Voice of America on station WLWO. Robert L, Drake's personal collection of Drake Radio products spanning from 1944 through the end of radio production. The West Chester Amateur Radio Association maintains a station at the VOA Museum operating under call sign WC8VOA. WCARA members and docents will be available during your visit. The museum has recently gone through a major renovation to our galleries and a new and expanded parking lot.
